| SB 25 | Authorize the Board of Regents to enter into a lease-purchase agreement to acquire agricultural property in Moody County for the use and benefit of the South Dakota State University Agricultural Experiment Station | Allows the Board of Regents to enter into a lease for no more than 15 years and no more than \$120,000 to be used as an agriculture experiment station | Referred to Senate Appropriations | Support |
| SB 26 | Authorize the Board of Regents to demolish the veterinary isolation building on the campus of South Dakota State University and to make an appropriation therefor. | Provides the authority for the Board of Regents to demolish the dilapidated isolation building used by the ADRDL and provides \$70,000 for the demolish of the building | Referred to Senate Appropriations | Support |
| HB 1058 | Revise certain provisions regarding contagious disease control quarantine measures and to declare an emergency. | Clarifies the Department of Health's authority to quarantine a person who harbors an infectious agent | Referred to House Health & Human Services; Scheduled for Hearing 1/20 | Monitor |
| SB 59 | Establish the state debt collection office | Creates a state debt collection office to collect any debt owed to any state agency, the board of regents, the Unified Judicial System or by a constitutional office. Among the remedies available to secure the collection of the debt is the authority to nonrenew any professional license. | Referred to Senate Commerce & Energy | Monitor |
| SB 61 | Place certain substances on the controlled substances schedule and to declare an emergency. | This is the annual update to the controlled substance schedule offered by the Department of Health. The update includes additional synthetic cannabinoids and Schedule II and III drugs | Referred to Senate Health & Human Services | Monitor |
